

TOBIN, MYRA RUGG
October 28, 1879-September 24, 1931

Mrs. Myra Rugg-Tobin, wife of J.A. Tobin of Laramie and daughter and sister of C.F. Rugg and Arthur Rugg of Wheatland, passed away in Denver, Thursday morning, September 24.

Mrs. Tobin had been ill the past six months and near the end, little hope was held for her recovery.

Christian Science services were held from the Congregational church Sunday afternoon at 2:30, Albert L. Digby of Denver, reading the service. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Lyla Watson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Tobin was born at Egbert, Wyo., October 28, 1879. She was married to John A. Tobin in Cheyenne 28 years ago. They resided in that city until they moved to Wheatland in September, 1911. Mr. Tobin was engaged in business here, and this was their home for ten years. From Wheatland, they moved to Rawlins where her husband was given the position of district foreman for the Union Pacific railroad. From Rawlins, they moved to Laramie and for the past 6 years have resided there. She is survived by her husband, father and brother and one daughter, Mrs. Ole Olafson of Laramie. She was an active member of the Christian Science church, a member of the Eastern Star of Rawlins, the Rebekah lodge of Wheatland and the Ladies of Gray Gables club of Laramie.
