

Charles M. Tomek

April 19, 1918 – February 14, 2006

Funeral Liturgy and Vigil for the Deceased for Charles M. Tomek, 87, was conducted at 10 a.m., Friday, Feb. 17 at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland with Father Jan Santich as the Celebrant. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

He died Tuesday, Feb. 14, 2006, at Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Charles was born April 19, 1918, in Temple, Texas, the son of Charles M. and Francis Tomek. He was reared and educated in Temple and served in the United States Air Force during World War II. Upon his discharge, he returned to Brownsville, Texas, and worked as a carpenter in construction. On April 17, 1960, Charles married Angelina L. Vera in Brownsville. They moved to Riverton, in 1965 and to Wheatland in 1974. He worked as a

farm laborer in Wyoming, retiring in 1971. Charles was a member of Saint Patrick Catholic Church and enjoyed fishing and camping in the mountains.

Survivors include his wife of 45 years, Angelina of Wheatland; four sons, William Tomek, George Tomek, and John Tomek all of Mexico, and Victor Tomek of Riverton; a twin sister, Francis Tomek Roper of Waco, Texas; two brothers, Stanley Tomek of Temple and Joe Tomek of Beaumont, Texas; six grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers, Alfonso Tomek, Frank Tomek, and Ludwig Tomek; and a sister, Julianna Tomek.
