

TRACY, CLAYTON ORIE

October 7, 1933-September 13, 1963

Clayton Orie Tracy died in the Sweetwater County Memorial Hospital at Rock Springs, Sept. 13, eighteen days after he was injured in a construction accident near Rock Springs. Tracy had been employed for Rieman-Wuerth Construction Co. for the past eight years and was superintendent of construction at the time of his death.

He was born Oct. 7, 1933 to Mr. and Mrs. Leo E. Tracy in Brigham City, Utah, and had resided in Cheyenne the past eight years. He was a Korean veteran and affiliated with the LDS church.

Funeral services were conducted by Bishop James M. Peterson and Rev. Elmo Mcloy at the Assembly of God church in Wheatland with interment in the Wheatland cemetery.
