William George (Bill) Trenholm died in Douglas on Sept. 2, 1982 at the age of 72.

He was born April 20, 1910 in Wheatland, the son of F.H. and Alice Williams Trenholm. He was educated in the Wheatland school system, graduating from the Wheatland High School in 1930. He ranched in the Wheatland and Glendo communities and was employed for a short time by the Platte County Road Maintenance Department. He then started a plumbing and heating business in Glendo which he remained active in until the time of his death.

On Oct. 1, 1937, Bill and Lucille Logan were married. The couple raised three sons, Francis of Gillette, Larry of Boise, Idaho and Robert of Story. They moved to Glendo in 1946.

He is survived by his wife, Lucille, of Glendo, his three sons and five grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, Robert and Leo; and a sister, Eunice.

Funeral services were held Monday, Sept. 6, 1982 at 10 a.m. at St. John the Baptist Episcopal Church in Glendo with the Father Wolfkeil officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
