

TROYER, ANDREW B.

December 15, 1851-August 19, 1938

Andrew B. Troyer passed away here Tuesday, August 19, at the age of eighty-seven years after a short illness.

Mr. Troyer moved to Wyoming in 1895 and has resided in this vicinity since that time.

Surviving are Mrs. Charles Weatherwax of Wheatland, Mrs. Ben F. Smith of Dwyer, and five other daughters living elsewhere. He was preceded in death by Mrs. Troyer in 1914, and a daughter, Mrs. William McLean, who died in Wheatland six years ago.

Andrew B. Troyer was born at Zaneville, Ohio December 15, 1851 and passed away at Wheatland, Wyoming August 19, 1938 after a short illness.

He was united in marriage in 1874 to Sarah Stutzman who preceded him in death in 1914. To this union, seven children were born, all of whom are living except one daughter, Mrs. William McLean who died in Wheatland April 22, 1932.

Those remaining are Mrs. Charles Weatherwax; Mrs. Ray Dickinson, Gering, Nebraska; Mrs. Henry Griesser, Cheyenne, Wyoming; Mrs. T.B. White, Chariton, Iowa; Mrs. Ben F. Smith, Dwyer, Wyoming and Mrs. W.W. Toyer, LaGrange, Wyoming. Several grandchildren also survive.

Mr. Troyer moved to Wyoming in 1895 and has resided in this vicinity ever since.
