

TRUJILLO, BONIFICIO S.
June 5, 1881-February 25, 1966

Last rites for Bonificio S. Trujillo, a Wheatland resident for twenty years, were held at St. Patrick's church at 10:00 a.m. Feb. 28, 1966 with Father Leonard Wren conducting the services. Burial was in the local cemetery. Rosary services were held at the Schrader chapel at 6:30 p.m. on Sunday.

Mr. Trujillo was born in Santa Cruz, New Mexico on June 5, 1881. He was employed as a shepherd for the Swan Land Co. for several years before he retired and moved to Wheatland. Death came suddenly at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Barney Juarez, in Wheatland, Feb. 25.
