

TUCKER, GEORGE F.

June 13, 1924-November9, 1931

George F. Tucker, 7-year old son of Mr. and Mrs. Finis Tucker, who live in the Antelope Gap country, died at his home Monday night at about 7:30, from injuries he received last Thursday when knocked to the ground by an automobile.

Funeral services are being held this afternoon, Thursday, at the Christian church, Rev. Morton of Guernsey preaching the funeral service and burial, with the Lyla Watson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements, will be made in the Wheatland cemetery.

The little boy was born in Kansas, June 13, 1924, and is survived by his parents and several brothers and sisters.

It will be remembered that the little boy was on his way home from school, and he, together with some little school chums, were waiting to be picked up in an auto driven by Miss Hazel Tucker, his sister, when the accident occurred. He rushed in front of the car and was knocked to the ground. He suffered concussion of the brain and several bad bruises. The former was responsible for his death.
