

TUCKER, JEAN GOEBEL
March 24, 1890-April 1, 1934

Easter was made a sad day at the Finis Tucker home when the death angel visited and took from it the wife and mother after only a short illness.

Jean Goebel Tucker was born at Scranton, Kansas, March 24, 1890, and passed away April 1, 1934, aged forty-four years, one week and one day.

She was united in marriage to Finis Tucker, March 11, 1908. To this union were born seven children: Mrs. Wilmer Beran, Mrs. Fred Brecht, Mildred, Glen, Dorothy, John and George, and a granddaughter Betty Lou. George preceded her in death three years ago.

Beside the husband and children left to mourn her passing is her father, John Goebel of Harner, Kansas; two brothers, Frank and John, three half brothers and three half sisters and a host of friends.

Mr. and Mrs. Tucker moved to Wyoming from Oklahoma in 1913 and homesteaded in Antelope Gap community where they have resided since.
