

TUCKER, JOSIAH D.
January 10, 1876-February 15, 1948

Josiah D. Tucker, 72, was born at Kellogg, Ia., January 10, 1876 and died at the local hospital on February 15, following a short illness. He was a retired farmer and a member of the Mormon church. He moved to this community in 1914 from Oklahoma, and resided here until the time of his death.

Survivors include two sons, Lloyd E. Tucker of Brisbane, Calif., Earl F. Tucker of Wheatland; three daughters, Mrs. Ada Searles Snokomish, Wash., Mrs. J.C.
