

TUGMON, THOMAS EDWARD

January 22, 1889-April 2, 1964

Last rites for Thomas Edward Tugmon, a resident of this area since 1910, were held at the Southern Baptist Church on Monday at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. Hawkins officiating. Military honors were held at the graveside in the Wheatland cemetery.

Tugmon was born in Bonita, Tex. on Jan. 22, 1889 to John and Ella Bohannon Tugmon, and succumbed in the VA Hospital in Cheyenne after an extended illness. A retired farmer, he was a World War I veteran and a member of the Southern Baptist Church.

Those left to mourn include his wife, Della; daughters Mrs. Ed (Evelyn) Stanker and Mrs. Ralph (Mary) Burchell of Denver; brothers, George of Chateau, Okla. And Fred of Stringtown, Okla.; a sister Lorena Workman of Atoka, Okla.; four grandchildren and two great grandchildren. A son Tommy preceded him in death in 1941.
