Joe Turcany, a foreigner, died at the gravel camp at Elkhorn, about five miles on the other side of Glendo, Tuesday afternoon.

According to the deputy coroner, H.G. Watson, the man died as a result of drinking too much canned heat. He was shipped from Denver Monday, to work in the gravel pit and upon his arrival he was under the influence of the canned heat, which caused his death Tuesday afternoon. He was brought to the Watson Mortuary and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery Wednesday afternoon at 3:00 o'clock.
