Frances Ellen Turner, 73, died Aug. 23, in Wheatland. Services were Aug. 25, at 2 p.m. in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel, Rev. Ken Saunders officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She was born Sept. 15, 1910 in Wheatland the daughter of Frank and Lorena Wickam. She attended Wheatland schools, graduating from Wheatland High School in 1929 and the University of Wyoming and Fort Collins College in Colo. Turner later taught in the Wheatland school system and in Platte County.

She married Percy T. Turner Sept. 22, 1929. They moved to California in 1959, living in San Jose for 16 years before returning to Wheatland in 1977.

She was a member of the U.S. Coast Guard during World War II, worked for the Wyoming Legislature in the late 1940s, was active in the Young Republican Club and in the Wheatland V.F.W.

Survivors include her husband, a daughter, Phyllis Shelton of Winnetka, Ill.; three brothers Morgan Wickam of Salem, Mo., Donald Wickam of Leadville, Colo., John Wickam of Wheatland; two sisters; Eunice Small of Wheatland, Virginia Baker of Madera, Calif., and four grandchildren.
