

TURNER, JAMES R.
February 27, 1884-April 16, 1964

James R. Turner, who resided seven miles south of Wheatland, died in the Platte County Memorial hospital on April 16, 1964, after a lengthy illness. He was born Feb. 27, 1884, in Worthing, S.D. to John and Ida Jenkins Turner. In later years, he served as Post Master at Ft. Yates, N.D. for eight years, and as an Indian trader with the Sioux Indians at Standing Rock Reservation for fifteen years. He moved to Wheatland in 1949.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. Irene Doleshy, of Amarillo, Tex.; a brother, John L. Turner of Wheatland; sisters, Mrs. J.W. Hawkes of Glenrock and Mrs. Louella Hokanson of Bismark, S.D. and several nieces and nephews. His wife succumbed a number of years ago.

Last rites will be held at the Schrader Chapel at 10:30 Monday morning with interment in the Wheatland cemetery.
