

TURNER, MARY ANN MEYERS  
October 6, 1867-November 4, 1960

Mrs. Ira (Mary Ann) Turner, 93, was born in Iowa City, Iowa, October 6, 1867 and passed away at the Platte County Memorial Hospital at Wheatland November 4, 1960. She had been hospitalized since October 13.

She was the daughter of William and Rebecca Russell Meyers and was united in marriage to Ira M. Turner October 1, 1886 at Mankato, Kans. She was a member of the Baptist church and had made her home her since 1911.

In the early years of their marriage, the Turners had lived in Oregon, making the trip with their children by wagon. Until the last few years when her health began to fail, Mrs. Turner was very active and devoted to her family and friends.

Funeral services were held Monday, November 17, from the Schrader Chapel at 2:00 p.m. with the Rev. Forrest Upchurch officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery. Pallbearers were Lester Cobb, Dee Bush, Gordon Drury, Frank Terry, John Nye and Doyle Hutchinson.
