

TURPEN, BLANCHE MORRISON

August 6, 1885-October 5, 1914

Mrs. James F. Turpen of this city, who had been in a low state of health for some time, died Monday at the Oaks Home in Denver. The funeral took place from the Congregational church in this city on Wednesday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
