Upon Dr. Phifer's return from Chicago last week, the sheriff called him to examine the body of the baby found in the irrigation canal. He proved to the satisfaction of the officers that the babe had been dead for several weeks and had been buried in the ground. It is believed that it was buried in a shallow grave, perhaps several miles away, and was probably washed into the canal by heavy rains. The suspicion of crime was abandoned, and the matter was dropped.
