

VERMILYEA, FLORENCE UVA RUTHERFORD

July 2, 1912-July 16, 1985

Services for Florence Uva Vermilyea, 73, who died in Wheatland on July 16, were held at 2 p.m. Friday in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Rev. Roy Gilliland officiating.

Vermilyea was born in Lexington, Nebr., July 2, 1912, the daughter of Harry T. and Lillian Guiles Rutherford. She spent her childhood in Dwyer, attended grade school there and graduated from high school in Wheatland.

She attended nursing school in Cheyenne and moved to Evansville in 1934. In 1952 she returned to Wheatland and married Revel C. Vermilyea in Dwyer.

She was employed for 15 years as a nurse at the Platte Co. Memorial Hospital. Upon retirement, she spent her time in Wheatland. She was a member of the First Baptist church.

She is survived by two brothers, Earl and Carl Rutherford, both of Wheatland, and two sisters, Leva Carlson of Yoder and Erma Vermilyea of Wheatland.

She was preceded in death by her husband in 1973 and by her parents, one brother and one sister.
