

Donald D. Vilott 1907 to 1996

Funeral services for Donald D. Vilott, 89, will be held Thursday, December 19, 1996, at 10:00 a.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating. Private inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Vilott died Sunday, December 15, 1996, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Donald was born April 1, 1907, in Mankato, Kansas, the son of Fletcher Burton and Lillian Harriet (Horreill) Vilott. He was reared and educated in Mankato; graduating from high school there.

He worked as a baker in Hastings, Nebraska before going into the construction business in Cheyenne building homes.

Then for fifty years, he owned and operated Western Trailer Sales in Cheyenne; retiring in 1977. He married his first wife, Edna in 1927 and they were

He then married Patricia Mooney Crates and they had resided in Wheatland for the past three years. Donald enjoyed tinkering and building and he loved the state of Wyoming.

Mr. Vilott is survived by his wife, Patricia of Wheatland; three children, Harry Vilott of San Diego, California, Joyce Aronvick of Chico, California, and donna Leffler of Grand Terrace, California; six grandchildren; and four great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; first wife, Edna, in 1990; a sister and a brother.
