Virgil Frank Vogt

Services for Virgil Frank Vogt, 82, who died in Wheatland, March 28, 1987, were held Tuesday in the First Christian Church in Wheatland at 2:00 p.m. with Chet Shaw, minister.

Virgil Frank Vogt was born in Riverdale, Neb., March 17, 1905, the son of Frank and Roxey (Pratt) Vogt. There he spent his childhood and received his education.

He and Nina Franzen were married at Kearney Feb. 15, 1933. To this union were born one son and two daughters. The family farmed in Nebraska around Elm Creek. In 1938 they moved to Wyoming where they farmed for several years. After moving into Wheatland Mr. Vogt worked at the Wheatland Co-op and the State Highway Department.

Besides his wife, Nina, of Wheatland, he is survived by one son, Darrel Vogt of Wheatland, daughters Bonnie Swingle of Cheyenne, Betty Fretz of Broomfield, Colo., a brother, Auldon Vogt of Wheatland, and two sisters: Marguerite Habel and Opal Franzen of Wheatland, twelve grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one infant brother and one sister.
