

WAGNER, KARL
1845-July 30, 1916

Karl Wagner, aged 71 years, died Sunday morning following a long period of declining health. He was born in Germany in 1845, emigrated to America and settled in Golden, Colo. in 1873. In 1875, he was married to Miss Fanny Titus of Denver, who survive him. Their home was at Golden until April last when they came to Wheatland to be nearer their daughter, Mrs. Geo. Carroll. Mr. Wagner was raised, lived and died a firm believer in the Christian faith. Funeral services will be held from the Congregational church this afternoon, conducted by Rev. A.T. Evans, and the body will be laid at rest in the Wheatland cemetery.
