

WALKER, HERBERT J.  
March 4, 1871-April 7, 1941

Herbert J. Walker died last Monday night from burns he incurred Sunday evening when the brooder stove he was lighting exploded. Flames from the explosion leaped up and ignited his clothing, badly burning his entire body. Mr. Walker was living alone on his homestead six miles south of Slater. Unable to treat himself, he walked a distance of two miles to the home of a neighbor, Mr. and Mrs. Swanson, who summoned medical aid.

Mr. Walker was born March 4, 1871, and at the time of his death was seventy years of age. He had made his home on the homestead since 1914.

Two children survive the deceased, Kenneth Walker who lives in Chugwater and a daughter residing in Pine Bluffs.

Funeral services will be conducted this afternoon from the Watson and Dennis chapel with the Rev. J.L. Williams officiating. Burial will be made in the Wheatland cemetery.
