

WALLACE, MRS. D.D.

It will be sad news to the many friends of the family throughout this section to learn of the death of Mrs. D.D. Wallace, which occurred in Denver recently. The remains were cremated and the ashes shipped to Wheatland for burial beside those of her husband and daughter, which are interred in the Wheatland cemetery. Services over Mrs. Wallace's remains were conducted at the cemetery on Wednesday.

Mr. and Mrs. Wallace were real pioneers of Wheatland. They built the Globe Hotel in 1894 and operated this popular hostelry for a number of years, later moving to their farm three miles south of Wheatland, now known as the J.L. Thompson place. Hazel, the only child, died at Wheatland about 1906, and Mr. Wallace passed away at the Denver home several years ago.
