

WANSING, NINA MARIE COLLINS

February 1, 1904-April 11, 1941

Death came Friday, April 11, to Mrs. Nina Wansing after an illness of long duration. She passed away in St. Luke's hospital in Denver, where she had been taken recently for treatment.

Nina Marie Wansing was born February 1, 1904 in Stillwater, Okla. to Mr. and Mrs. James G. Collins. In 1921, she was married to Charles Cole. To this union, two sons were born, Charles Dean and Bernard Eugene.

On February 2,, 1921 (?), she was united in marriage to John Wansing. To them, one daughter, Joan Eileen, was born.
