

Bertha Elizabeth Washburn 1909-1995

Graveside services and interment for Bertha Elizabeth Washburn, 86, were held Thursday, November 30, 1995, at 10:00 a.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland, with Pastor Randy Raver of the Assembly of God Church officiating.

Mrs. Washburn died Saturday, November 25, 1995, at the Clear Creek Care Center in Westminster, Colorado.

Bertha was born October 12, 1909, the daughter of Frank and Zelda (McCartney) Walthers, in Swink, Colorado. She was reared and educated in the Swink area.

On February 20, 1929, she married Bernard C. Washburn in Brighton, Colorado. They moved to the Wheatland area and lived there until 1989 when they moved to Montana. In September of 1994 she moved to the Denver, Colorado area.

She is survived by a son, Dewey Washburn of Commerce City, Colorado; two sisters, Doris Hoffman and Maude Lorenz both of Wheatland; a brother, Frank Walthers of Westminster, Colorado; nine grandchildren and seventeen great grandchildren.
