

WEATHERWAX, CHARLES MUSKER

?-March 17, 1945

Funeral services were held in the Schrader chapel Tuesday at 2 p.m. for C.M. Weatherwax who died in the Wheatland General hospital last Saturday, March 17, following a nine-day stay. The Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiated.

Charles Musker Weatherwax was born in Iowa and came to this community 40 years ago. He was a retired farmer and since the death of his wife in July, 1944, had made his home with his son John, 18 miles northeast of Wheatland.

He is survived by his son, John; two brothers and one sister of Denver; and four grandchildren.

Pallbearers included Wes Blevens, Joe Webber, John Monger, Roy Kerschner, Charles Romig and Boyd Herstein. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery beside his wife.
