

WEATHERWAX, EMMA MAY TROYER  
May 8, 1876-July 31, 1944

Mrs. Emma May Weatherwax, 68, passed away in the Wheatland hospital July 31 as a result of burns incurred when she poured kerosene in a cook stove, causing it to explode, Thursday afternoon, July 27.

Mrs. Weatherwax, who was born in Indiana, May 8, 1876, and has been a resident of Platte county for the past 49 years, is survived by her husband, Charles M.
