May 24, 1906-August 31, 1975

Retired rancher, Donald Ralph Welty, succumbed to an extended illness Sunday, August 31, 1975, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital. He was 69.

Rev. Elliott Graves presided over funeral services at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home, Wednesday, September 3, 1975. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
