

WELTY, SHIRLEY E. ARBOGAST

June 23, 1909-July 1, 1989

A memorial service for Shirley E. Welty, 80, who passed away July 1, 1989, at Cheyenne, was held at 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 11, at Wheatland Bible Church. Cremation has already taken place.

Shirley E. Welty was born June 23, 1909 at Bartley, Neb., the daughter of Jade W. and Lilly (Rawson) Arbogast.
