August 23, 1871-January 18, 1920

On August 23, 1871, Grant West was born in Wapello county, Iowa. He grew to young manhood in that state. About twenty-five years ago, he came to Wyoming where he has since resided in various places, but for the last several years he has lived at his home ranch on Fish Creek where he departed this life Jan. 18, 1920, age 48 years, 4 months and 20 days.

On October 6, 1895, he and Miss Sara Nora Phelps were united in marriage and to this union two children were born: a son Herbert Austin who died in infancy and Mabel Dell who was recently married to M. Bertram Richards. The wife and the daughter are the immediate family left to mourn the untimely departure of a loving and devoted husband and parent. There are several brothers and sisters located in Iowa, Colorado and Wyoming. Mr. West was a member of the Woodman lodge, having been affiliated with the lodge for 23 years. He was a regular attendant at the Dwyer Route Sunday school and Farm Bureau and his presence will be sadly missed by these organizations which were greatly helped by his presence.

Funeral services were held Jan. 20 at the Congregational church in Wheatland conducted by Rev. Paxton, an old friend of the family, who spoke words of comfort to the bereaved. After the services at the church, the internment was made in the Wheatland cemetery, where the remains were tenderly consigned to their last resting place, there to await the final resurrection.
