

Former Resident, Frances Westfall Dies In Rhode Is.

Mrs. Frances Westfall, 88 of Barrington, R. I., formerly of Dwyer and Wheatland, died Monday, Feb. 14 at Barrington. She attended schools at Wheatland and also taught in that community. 1970

Mrs. Westfall was born Feb. 24, 1907, in Springfield, Vt., and had lived in the Wheatland area for most of her life before moving to Rhode Island in 1945.
