

WHALEN, ELLA BELLE
June 22, 1895-April 28, 1953

Funeral services were held last Saturday in Wheatland at the Schrader chapel for Miss Ella Belle Whalen, 59, a resident of Wheatland since 1903, having been born in Palmer, Neb. on June 22, 1895. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J.A. Whalen, early Wheatland settlers.

Because of ill health, Miss Whalen to Canton, Ohio two years ago to live with her sister, Mrs. Harold Branch. She passed away in Canton on April 28, and the body was returned here for burial in the family plot at the Wheatland cemetery.
