

WICKAM, FLOYD EVERETT
1912-February 8, 1916

Mr. and Mrs. Joe Wickam had the misfortune of losing their little son, Master Floyd Everett, who died at 2:15 Monday morning, February 8th, after an illness of less than 24 hours.

Master Floyd was apparently in good health until Sunday morning, when he began to complain of illness after breakfast. Thinking it was merely a temporary attack of stomach trouble, his parents did not call a physician until late in the afternoon when acute symptoms were manifested. He grew steadily worse from then on, and after 10 p.m., he went into convulsions, passing away in four hours.

He was three years, 10 months and one day old when he died. The funeral was held from the E.L. Rumsey home Tuesday evening, Rev. H.E. Shepherd preaching the funeral sermon. Mr. and Mrs. Wickam have the entire sympathy of the community in their loss.
