

Last Rites To Be Held June 13 For Louis E. Wiegand

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, June 13, 1970, at 10:30 a.m. in the Schrader Chapel in Wheatland for Louis Edward Wiegand who passed away on Sunday, June 7, 1970, in the Cheyenne Veterans Hospital of an extended illness.

Mr. Wiegand lived in Wheatland from 1908-1950 at which time he moved to Cheyenne. He was employed as custodian of schools. Born in Plymouth, Nebraska on Oct. 2, 1896 he served in WWI in the armed forces, and was affiliated with the Lutheran Church.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Violet, in 1918, and his second, wife, Florence, in 1960.
