Mrs. Mary Wilkinson, a resident of this community since 1885, passed away Sunday, Jan. 10, after a short illness. She was the widow of John Wilkinson who died a few years ago.

Mrs. Wilkinson was born in Ireland and came to this country as a small girl. She was seventy-nine years of age at the time of her death. Mrs. Wilkinson is survived by four sons.

Mrs. Mary Wilkinson, a resident of this community, passed away at her home on Sunday, January 10. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Mullen and was born in Ireland. She was 79 years of age at the time of her death. She came to this country when a girl of 13, and the family lived in Philadelphia, Pa.

At the age of 29, she was joined in Holy wedlock to John Wilkinson, and in July 1887, they moved to the Wheatland ranch community and lived here until her demise.

She is survived by four sons, Thomas, Frank, John T. and William; two grandsons, George and Harold Wilkinson; one brother, John T. Mullen of Wheatland; three sisters, Margaret T. Mullen, Mrs. Ella McSorly and Jennie Reimel, all of Philadelphia. Mrs. Reimel and daughter Mrs. Walter Metz were here to attend the funeral.

Services were held from the Catholic church Saturday morning and interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson & Dennis Home for Funerals in charge of arrangements.
