Services for Leo Williams, 72, who died at his home in Wheatland May 4, 1986 will be held Wednesday, May 7, 1986 in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel at 2:00 p.m. with Pastor Don Moore officiating.

Born in LaVerne, Okla., Nov. 30, 1913, Leo was the son of Thomas A. and Ivie (Grinstead) Williams. In 1927 he and his family moved to Wheatland.
