First Lt. Francis E. Wilson, AAF, killed in action in North Africa
1942, B-25 navigator-bombardier: plane presumably shot
down over the Mediterranean sea and never recovered.
(all lost).

Lt. Wilson, son of G.E. (Dick) Wilson, and Annie Laurie
Wilsonof, Wheatland, Wyoming.

G.E. (Dick) Wilson veteran of WWI in France.

Lt. Wilson attended Wheatland High School (class of 1935):
later college in Missouri.

Lt. Wilson helped on the family farm and ranch.
His buddies called him cowboy.

Lt. Wilson was a brother of Maurine Wilson Bellis,
and best man at the wedding in 1937 when she married
Max Bellis at the farm near Wheatland.
