

WILSON, JAMES P.
September 16, 1896-November 3, 1918

A message was received Saturday conveying the message that James Wilson had died of pneumonia at Camp McArthur, Texas, on Friday. He was the son of Charles Wilson, a well-known ranchman on the North Laramie. The young man was called into service on Oct. 24th, and had scarcely reached camp when he was stricken with the prevailing epidemic and death soon followed. The body was shipped back to Wheatland for burial.
