

WITT, BERT E.
April 17, 1894-March 9, 1951

Bert E. Witt, retired Wheatland farmer died last Friday, March 9, at his home from a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

Born April 17, 1894 in Saline county, Nebr., the deceased came to this community from McCook, Nebr. in 1916. He was a veteran of World War I.

Surviving are his wife, Lela M. Witt of Madison, Wisc.; three children, Hazel E. Grames of St. Louismo., Lela Alberta Johnson of Rockford, Ill. and Raymond W. Witt of Wheatland; four brothers; four sisters; and two grandchildren. A son, Keith B. Witt, was killed in World War II.

Last rites were conducted at 2 p.m. in the Schrader chapel by Mr. C.E. Henry and burial was in Wheatland. Pallbearers were Ivan Hooley, Jack Jones, Merle Logan, C.J. Hauf, Mike Coleman and William Hill.
