

# Charles 'Chick' William Woolsey

February 12, 1934 – May 4, 2011

After semi-retiring Chick enjoyed taking vari-

ous pictures, taking pictures at Old Grads weekend, and of the 4-H Tailwaggers. He enjoyed building RC Airplanes and flying them with his friends. Motorcycles were an enjoyment to Chick too.
