

WOOLSEY, GEORGE G.
October 29, 1900-November 30, 1973

George G. Woolsey, 73, a resident of Wheatland, Wyo., succumbed Friday, November 30, 1973, at DePaul Hospital, Cheyenne, Wyo., after a brief illness. George was born at Kansas, October 29, 1900 and moved to Platte County in 1907. He married Mae I. Barrett in 1925 in Wheatland. Mr. Woolsey was a retired farmer. He was a member of the First Christian Church and also active in the Rock Lake Grange.
