

WORTHINGTON, ELLA RUTH NIEBRUGGE

September 10, 1895-January 6, 1924

Mrs. Harry Worthington died Sunday after an illness of several months, the immediate cause of her death being a hemorrhage of the lungs.

The deceased was born in Napoleon, Ind. on Sept. 10, 1895, where she grew up to young womanhood, graduating from the Indiana state university and taking special work at the Terra Haute Normal school. After leaving school, she was engaged in teaching 5 years, during one of which she was in charge of the home economics department of the Wheatland High school.

She was married to Harry Worthington on May 27, 1922. To this union was born one son, Jack Elwood Worthington, aged three months. Other surviving relatives are her husband, her mother, Mrs. Niebrugge of Terra Haute, Ind. and a brother. The funeral was held Tuesday afternoon from the Methodist church, the services being conducted by Mrs. L.C. Butler.

A large number of friends and former pupils remain here to mourn her untimely death.
