

ZOHNER, CHARLES JOSEF  
October 15, 1891-November 22, 1955

Death came Tuesday, November 22 to Carl Josef (Charles) Zohner, 64 after a hospitalization of five weeks in Wheatland.

Zohner, colorful figure and resident of the Wheatland Flats for about 40 years, was living on his farm four miles southwest of Wheatland at the time of his illness, having made his home there for the past ten years. He was born October 15, 1891.

A member of several organizations, Mr. Zohner was a hard worker in the various groups with which he was associated. He was affiliated with the IOOF lodge, the Rock Lake Grange and the Farmers Union.

Zohner devoted many years of service to the Wheatland Irrigation District, serving both as secretary and vice president of the board of directors. In his own district, 4, he was director from the fall of 1947 until February, 1953.

At the time of his death, Zohner was county chairman of the Agriculture and Stabilization committee, having served in this capacity since 1953. He had been connected with this organization since 1940.

Survivors are a son, Charles D. of Pasco, Wash.; a daughter, Marion (Mrs. Richard) Preuit of Wheatland; a brother, John of Battle Creek, Nebr., and four grandchildren. His wife, Hazel preceded him in death in August, 1944.

Last rites will be conducted at the Christian church, with arrangements by Schraders, and interment in the Wheatland cemetery.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon, November 26 at 2 p.m.
