

ZUCHER, IDA BERTHA
March 20, 1857-May 16, 1933

Mrs. Ida Bertha Zucher, mother of Rev. W.T. Zucher of the Bethlehem Evangelical church, passed away Tuesday, May 16th at 1:30 P.M. at the home of Rev. and Mrs. G.T. Zucher. The Deceased was born in Germany the 20th of March, 1857. When she was 25 years old, she became the bride of the Missionary T.W. Zucher and lived and labored with her husband for nearly twenty years on the West Coast of snowbound Greenland. Five children had to be laid in an early grave in Greenland and one son died in Germany. She came back to Germany from Greenland in 1900 and was at her husband's side there until he died twenty years ago on May 1913.

In 1923, her son, G.T. Zucher came to the United States bringing her and her youngest daughter, Miss Sarah Zucher. She had been in poor health since February, 1925 when she had a severe stroke. She moved to Wheatland in September, 1931. Although being in poor health and confined to her bed the past three months, her death came unexpectedly.

She is survived by her two children and her daughter-in-law, Mrs. G.T. Zucher, who cared for her all the long years very faithfully, also by one sister and two brothers in Germany, one granddaughter, Miss Margaret Zucher of Wheatland.

Funeral services will be held Saturday at 1:00 P.M. with Rev. Henry Baumgaertel of Winsor, Colo., President of the Colorado District of the Evangelical Synod of N.A. with some other ministers of the Synod officiating, with Copley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. Burial will be made in the Wheatland cemetery.
